Humphreys Middle School Visits Sister School in Korea




On Thursday, April 24, 2025, 17 students from Mrs. Burton's Explore Foreign Language class had the exciting opportunity to visit our sister school, Neungdong Middle School, in Hawseong. This was our second visit to Neungdong this school year, and it was once again a day filled with cultural exchange, learning, and fun. During the visit, our students shadowed their Korean buddies for two class periods, giving them a glimpse into everyday school life in Korea. In addition to attending classes, they took part in engaging cultural activities, including crafting traditional 자기 (mother-of-pearl) keychains, playing the popular Dalgona (sugar cookie) game, and enjoying a lively round of "Red Light, Green Light."

- Students also had the chance to try a Korean school lunch, which was a new and enjoyable experience for many. Sharing a meal together added another layer to the cultural immersion and offered a taste of daily life in Korean schools.
- Perhaps the most meaningful part of the day was the time spent building friendships. Through shared experiences and laughter, students from both schools created strong connections that went beyond language barriers.

Honoring Parents Through Korean Calligraphy Mrs. Burton's Intercultural Ed and Explore Foreign Language Classes



In honor of Korean Parents' Day (어버이날; May 8) and Mother's Day (May 11), students in Mrs. Burton's Intercultural Education and Explore Foreign Language classes engaged in a hands-on cultural experience.

Students learned the basics of Korean calligraphy, including how to properly hold a calligraphy pen and practice brush strokes. Each student created a scroll with a personalized message for their parents or mother. Some chose to include a hand-drawn carnation—a meaningful Korean symbol of respect and love for parents—while others expressed their appreciation through thoughtful calligraphy alone.

This special activity offered students a chance to explore a meaningful Korean tradition while expressing gratitude in a creative way.


